TOP TIPS TO HELP AVOID COUNTERFEITS

- Beware of "too good to be true" prices.
- Be careful when buying through foreign sites.
- Purchase from authorized dealers or directly from the manufacturer.

RED FLAGS TO LOOK FOR

- Check to make sure your battery fits easily in your device.
- Check for overheating.
- Make sure your battery holds a charge.
- Compare logos for consistency.

SURE-FIRE WAY TO PROTECT YOURSELF
